1 Apologises/Welcome

Present: Cllr Laurence Mathers (Chairman), Cllr Richard Roberts and Cllr Robert Blyth.

3 Matters arising from previous Minutes

3a Matters arising

It was stated that the frequency of The Convent Farm bonfires had subsided over the winter period. Cllr Michael Morris is to report back at the next Parish Meeting.

3b Condition of carriageway Rising Lane

Councillors, yet again, expressed their concern over the condition of the carriageway in Rising Lane. The Clerk mentioned she had contacted County Cllr John Cooke, following the last Parish Council meeting and relayed the Parish Councillors' concerns. Councillors suggested the Clerk report each pothole via the WCC website, until it is repaired.

3c Speed Watch

The Clerk mentioned she has received a completed Police vetting form from Cllr Robert Blyth. Some vetting forms are still outstanding from those willing to volunteer to staff Speed Watch.

3d State of Public footpath/Bridleway leading from Convent Farm - Netherwood Lane

Cllr Morris previously reported that the current state of the public footpath leading from Convent Farm to Netherwood Lane is waterlogged and impossible to use. The Clerk reported this issue to the Rights of Way Officer, Richard Barnard at Warwick District Council and sent several reminders without response.

3e Use of Village Green

Councillors agreed that playing ball games on the Village Green was dangerous to oncoming traffic, and potentially to the children playing as they may run out into the road to collect the ball. Generally Village Greens have 'No Ball Games' signs displayed, and it was agreed the Clerk should research current byelaws and investigate the cost of a sign/s and installation.
